OFFICIAL RULES

1. Tournament will be held regardless of weather. If conditions threaten, please exercise extreme caution.
2. All participants **MUST** check in at Yarborough Landing and go through a livewell check the morning of the tournament. Check-in will begin at 5:00 a.m. All participants must launch from Yarborough Landing and may do so anytime following check in and livewell check. This tournament is an “ON-YOUR-HOLE-START”. Participants may not begin fishing until 6:45 a.m. Official time shall be kept by the tournament director.
3. This is catch and **RELEASE** tournament. **ALL FISH WEIGHED BECOME THE PROPERTY OF RODBENDERS AND WILL BE RELEASED BACK INTO THE LAKE.** NO DEAD FISH SHALL BE PRESENTED FOR WEIGHING. DEAD FISH WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION OF ENTIRE STRINGER AND BIG BASS. All bass presented for weighing must be brought to the scales in a weigh-in bag with water.
4. All Federal and State laws apply. Only largemouth and/or Spotted Kentucky bass (black bass) may be presented for weighing. ALL fish presented for weighing must be 16 inches in length minimum. Official measuring board is the Golden Rule by Gator Grip.
5. **Participants must be in weigh-in line by 3:30 P.M.!** This is a team tournament with a 5-fish limit. Total weight of stringer will determine standings.
6. All bass presented for weighing must be caught by legal methods on the tournament lake during tournament hours. Artificial lures only.
7. No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed during tournament hours.
8. USCG approved life-jackets shall be worn when boat is above idle speed with kill switch attached on remote steer outboards.
9. Sportsmanship, safety, courtesy, and conservation are expected from all participants.
10. Participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or an adult with written parental consent.
11. All decisions by the Tournament Director are Final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Tournament Director within 15 minutes of the end of the tournament. Any participant found to be in violation of tournament rules is subject to disqualification. Tournament Officials reserve the right to refuse ANY entry.
12. All participants, by signing the entry form and/or participating in the tournament, are subject to polygraph examination. Refusal to submit to polygraph examination will be cause for disqualification.
